High Commission of India Dar es Salaam

Advisory dated 5th May 2020

Over the last few weeks, a large number of Indian nationals have registered themselves using the link available at the website of the High Commission. At the same time, many Indian nationals have been writing to the High Commission enquiring about the possibility of their flying back to India. Several individual 'Whatsapp' groups have been collecting information on their own and promising priority air evacuation to those registering with them.

- 2. It is clarified that these 'WhatsApp' groups have no authorization from the Government of India and in many cases, this can lead to unnecessary panic and misleading information, even if it was not intended to be so.
- 3. The Government of India accords high priority to the welfare of its nationals abroad and hence strategies and options need to be worked out keeping in mind the global spread of Indian diaspora. The process of evacuation has started and its scope, schedule & guidelines will be decided by the Government. Priority obviously is being given to the most compelling and vulnerable cases.
- 4. High Commission of India in Tanzania has been preparing its data base on the basis of requests being received from Indian community. The requests need to be sent in the format given below:
