ICCR Scholarship for studies in India for the Academic Year 2022-23

High Commission of India, Dar es Salaam has the honour to announce the Scholarships under the Africa Scholarship Scheme of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) for Tanzanian Nationals for pursuing Undergraduate, Post-graduate and doctoral courses in Indian Universities for academic year starting in July 2022.

Submission of application is acceptable only through A2A Portal www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in/ (A2A portal). Applicants are advised to go through the guidelines available on A2A portal and submit the application online only latest by 31st May 2022. For any technical assistance in the application procedure, the applicant may contact a2asupport.iccr@gov.in.

Applicants should exercise due diligence and research in a dedicated manner on the specific admission criteria laid down by various Universities for each subject, and ensure that they submit all relevant documentation as required by the Universities in addition to the basic certificates mentioned in the application form. Those applying for post-graduate and doctoral courses should check specialization and eligibility requirement with greater care.

The scholarship includes return economy class air-fares to the nearest airport to the place of study, apart from tuition fees paid to the institute and a monthly stipend.

Applicants have the option to apply to 5 Universities / Institutes in the order of their preference of study. Placement to a particular educational institution / University will depend on the availability of seats and the course that have been chosen.

Applicants age should be between 18 to 30 years old at the time of admission. In respect of PhD programme, the age limit is 45years. Only students proficient in English may apply for admission since all teaching will be in English. A 500-word essay in English has been introduced to ascertain English Proficiency. Besides, students can also submit their TOEFL/IELTS etc. standardize Test scores, if available.

Personal medical insurance is a mandatory requirement for availing ICCR's scholarship. ICCR will not be offering medical coverage.

Once the application has been submitted online, applicants must regularly check the A2A portal and their email for any updates.

Universities to inform the decision to students:	15 June 2022
Last date for allocating scholarship and generating Offer Letters:	30 June 2022
Last date of acceptance by students:	15th July 2022
