The document will be received up to **1500hrs on 27.01.2025 and** will be opened on the same day at 1530 hrs.
- **4.0** If any information furnished by the applicant is found incorrect at a later stage, he/she shall be liable to be debarred from the tendering process. The High Commission of India reserves the right to verify the particulars furnished by the applicant independently.
- **5.0** The High Commission of India, Dar es Salaam reserves the right to reject any tender and to annul the tendering process and reject all tenders at any time prior to Contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to tenderers.

#### **Terms & Conditions**

- 1. The bidder will have to ensure compliance of all mandatory Laws/regulations laid down by the Government of the Tanzania and any other relevant Acts and regulations enforceable from time to time without any liability on the High Commission of India, Dar-es-Salaam or without any responsibility for statutory compliance by the Mission.
- 2. Details of the financial background of the company.
- 3. <u>Code of Integrity:</u> all bidders should observe the highest standard of ethics and should not indulge in the following prohibited practices, either directly or indirectly, at any stage during the tender process or during execution of resultant contract:
  - 3.1. "Corrupt practice": making offers, solicitation or acceptance of bribe, rewards, gifts or any material benefit, in exchange for an unfair advantage in the tender process or to otherwise influence the tender process or contract execution;
  - 3.2. "Fraudulent practice": any omission or misrepresentation that may mislead or attempt to mislead so that financial or other benefits may be obtained or in obligation avoided. This includes making false declaration or providing false information for participation in a tender process or to secure the contract or execution of the contract;
  - 3.3. "Anti-competitive practice": any collusion, bid rigging or anti-competitive arrangement or any other practice coming under the purview of the Competition Act, 2002, between two or more bidders, with or without the knowledge of the High Commission of India Dar es Salaam, that may impair the transparency, fairness and the progress of the tender process or to establish bid prices at prices at artificial, non-competitive levels;
  - 3.4. "Coercive practice": harming or threatening to harm, persons or their property to influence their participation in the tender process or affect the execution of the contract;
- 4. <u>Duration of Contract</u>: The contract will be valid till the completion of work/ delivery of books at the High Commission of India, Dar es Salaam. The successful bidder (L-1) should be ready to provide the delivery of books before 07 February 2025.
- 5. Right to accept any bid and to reject any or all bids: The High Commission of India, Dar-es-Salaam, at its own discretion, accept or reject any bid/quotation without assigning any reasons thereof. The decision of the High Commission of India shall be final and binding on all.
- 6. The High Commission of India may terminate this contract, if the service provider is not able complete the work within agreed time period.
- 7. The service provider shall pay the expenses of applicable duties for execution of agreement.
- 8. If the service provider imposes any condition, in conflict with the conditions mentioned herein, his tender is liable to be summarily rejected. In any case, none of such conditions will be deemed to have been accepted unless specifically mentioned in the letter of acceptance of tender issued by the High Commission of India.
- 9. The tendering authority (High Commission of India) reserves the right to accept any

tender not necessarily the lowest, reject any tender without assigning any reasons and accept tender for all or anyone or more of the articles for which the service provider has submitted bid.

- 10. Any bid received by the tendering authority after the deadline for submission of bids will be rejected and not be considered and may be returned unopened to the service provider.
- 11. The tender bid shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 07 days from the last date of submission.
- 12. The rates quoted by the service provider shall be deemed to include all taxes and duties etc. as applicable. Liability, if any, towards staff and employees from principal employer's end shall be deemed to be included in the offer.
- 13. The service provider would need to ensure that all books being provided must be new and not refurbished.
- 14. <u>Validation of Contract</u>: The contract shall be valid till the delivery of books at High Commission of India, Dar es Salaam.
- 15. <u>Taxes and Duties</u>: The bidder must include in their bids all duties, royalties and sales/service taxes or any other taxes, fees, charges as applicable. the High Commission of India will entertain no extra claim on this amount at any stage of execution of work. In case of any variations in the taxes, the same shall be charged after producing the Government notification.
- 16. Execution Method: NA
- 17. <u>Terms of Payment</u>: The payments shall be made within one month of the delivery of books at the High Commission of India.

- 18.   - 19. The tender forms shall be neatly filled in ink or typed. No tender filled in pencil will be considered. The tender shall be signed, dated and duly witnessed in all places provided for in the documents. All corrections/deletions/scoring out/over writing shall be initialed. Any correction made in the tender documents by the bidder shall be made in ink only and not by using correcting fluid, and should duly be authenticated. Every page of the tender shall be initialed by the bidder, and submitted back as a token of accepting the laid down terms and condition. The bidder shall sign all schedule forming part of the tender.
  - 20. <u>Late Bids</u>: The bidders are advised, in their own interest, to ensure that the tender document reaches the High Commission of India well before the closing date and time of the bid submission. Any bid received after the deadline shall be rejected and returned
